

All CAA officials registering for each season – NEW OR RENEWAL - will need to present a fingerprint card upon submitting their registration to the Canyon Athletic Association.

PROCESS:

- 1) **FINGER PRINTING.** You will need to get your Finger Prints done. This process can be done by:
 - Various law enforcement agencies around the state.
 - Arizona Live Scan (CLICK HERE)
 - Community Wellness and Safety of Arizona (CLICK HERE)
 - Field Print (<u>CLICK HERE</u>)
- 2) **AZ DPS APPROVAL.** After your finger print document is completed, approval from the AZ DPS is required in order to get your Finger Print Clearance Card. Attach your fingerprint document (step #1) to the DPS form and mail it to DPS.
 - FYI. It takes about 4-6 weeks for the card to arrive once cleared.
 - The DPS clearance is valid for 6 years.
