FINANCIAL REPORT:

The Financial Reports were presented. September financials were **APPROVED**

APPEALS/ISSUES

- Official reinstatement Request to be allowed back into CAA pool DENIED
- A+ Charter Classification appeal for combining of schools approval **DENIED** any team that has 5 or more athletes will be required to compete in D.3 per CAA bylaw.
- Mission Heights Prep Exemption to allow girls soccer players to play on the boys soccer team APPROVED max of 3 athletes allowed to be added to the roster, Mission Heights Prep offers
 girls soccer in the Spring.
- **Heritage Academy Gateway**: High School student transfer eligibility appeal reviewed based on new information that verifies a student was enrolled by August 1st enrollment date, eligibility is granted immediately. **APPROVED**
- Northpointe Academy Requesting to allow 3 student athletes from Canyon View Prep to participate on the High School Volleyball team because school cancelled Volleyball season. APPROVED school is reclassified to Division 2, listed as an independent.
