

**ARTICLE 15:**  
**All State**

**15.1 ALL-STATE TEAMS**

15.1.1 The CAA will recognize High School Varsity student-athletes for the following CAA varsity sports: Baseball, Boys Basketball, Girls Basketball, Tackle Football, Boys Soccer, Girls Soccer, Coed Soccer, Softball, Boys Volleyball, Girls Volleyball, Sand Volleyball, HS Flag Football

15.1.2 The CAA will limit the selection to the ALL-STATE TEAM under the following guidelines:

Tackle Football: Division 1- 18 players Division 2 -18 players  
HS Flag Football: Division 1-7 players Division 2 - 7 players  
Boys Soccer: Division 1-11 players Division 2 - 11 players  
Girls Soccer: Division 1-11 players Division 2 - 11 players  
Coed Soccer: Division 1-11 players Division 2 - 11 players  
Baseball: Division 1-9 players Division 2 - 9 players  
Softball: Division 1-9 players Division 2 - 9 players  
Boys Volleyball: Division 1-6 players Division 2 - 6 players  
Girls Volleyball: Division 1-6 players Division 2 - 6 players  
Sand Volleyball: Division 1- 4 players  
Girls Basketball: Division 1-5 players Division 2 -5 players  
Boys Basketball: Division 1-5 players Division 2 -5 players Division 3-5 players

15.1.3 The CAA will limit the selection of Honorable Mention Athletes under the following guidelines:

Tackle Football: Division 1- 5 players Division 2 -5 players  
HS Flag Football: Division 1-5 players Division 2 -5 players  
Boys Soccer: Division 1-5 players Division 2 -5 players  
Girls Soccer: Division 1-5 players Division 2 - 5 players  
Coed Soccer: Division 1-5 players Division 2 - 5 players  
Baseball: Division 1-5 players Division 2 - 5 players  
Softball: Division 1-5 players Division 2 - 5 players  
Boys Volleyball: Division 1-5 players Division 2 - 5 players  
Girls Volleyball: Division 1-5 players Division 2 -5 players  
Sand Volleyball: Division 1- 4 players  
Girls Basketball: Division 1-5 players Division 2 -5 players  
Boys Basketball: Division 1-5 players Division 2 -5 players Division 3-5 players

15.1.4 Only high school student-athletes (students in grades 9-12) are eligible to be recognized on these teams even though student-athletes in grades 7 and 8 can play on HS varsity teams.

15.1.5 Schools failing to comply with the guidelines defined in Article 8 will be held accountable per the guidelines established in Article 10.

## **15.2 ALL-REGION TEAM Selection Process**

- 15.2.1 Each region in a sport will have it's participating teams meet at the conclusion of regular season to select an ALL-REGION TEAM , Region Coach of the Year and Region Honorable Mention Athletes
- 15.2.2 Each participating region team gets only one ballot in this process
- 15.2.3 The region members will (by consensus) determine the date and time of when this selection meeting will occur
- 15.2.4 The region members will hold this meeting either in person or virtual or combination of both
- 15.2.5 This meeting is being held for open discussion purposes to identify the most worthy candidates
- 15.2.6 Region Members will electronically fill out their Region ballot and send to the CAA office within 24 hours of the conclusion of their respective region meeting
- 15.2.7 The ALL-REGION TEAM will be comprised of the top vote recipients in order to fill out the respective number of ALL-Region members for that sport. If there's a tie for the last spot that would exceed the maximum selection number for that sport, the spot will be awarded to the highest ranking class athlete (e.g. Highest to lowest - Senior, Junior, Sophomore, Freshman)
- 15.2.8 The Honorable Mention athletes will be those athletes receiving the highest number of votes that did not get selected to the ALL-REGION TEAM
- 15.2.9 The Region Coach of the Year will be the coach receiving the highest number of votes. If there is a tie the CAA Staff will decide which coach of those involved in the tie will receive the award.
- 15.2.10 The Region members will select a region representative to act as a coordinator with responsibility to represent the region at the ALL-STATE TEAM selection meeting.
- 15.2.11 All region team recipients will receive recognition on the CAA website.

## **15.3 ALL-STATE TEAM Selection Process**

- 15.3.1 Eligibility to be selected to the ALL-STATE TEAM for a specific sport, a student athlete must have been selected to the ALL-REGION TEAM
- 15.3.2 Each Region Coordinator in a sport will meet at the conclusion of State Tournament to select an ALL-STATE TEAM , Coach of the Year and Honorable Mention Athletes
- 15.3.3 Each participating Region Coordinator gets only one ballot in this process
- 15.3.4 The CAA Sports Administrators will determine the date and time of this selection meeting
- 15.3.5 The Region Coordinators will hold this meeting either in person or virtual or combination of both
- 15.3.6 This meeting is being held for open discussion purposes to identify the most worthy candidates
- 15.3.7 Region Coordinators will electronically fill out their ALL-STATE ballot and send to the CAA office within 24 hours of the conclusion of their respective STATE selection meeting
- 15.3.8 The ALL-STATE TEAM will be comprised of the top vote recipients in order to fill out the respective number ALL-STATE members for that sport. If there's a tie for the last spot that would

exceed the maximum selection number for that sport, the spot will be awarded to the highest ranking class athlete (e.g. Highest to lowest - Senior, Junior, Sophomore, Freshman)

15.2.9 The Honorable Mention athletes will be those athletes receiving the highest number of votes that did not get selected to the ALL-STATE TEAM

15.2.10 The Coach of the Year will be the coach receiving the highest number of votes. If there is a tie the CAA Staff will decide which coach of those involved in the tie will receive the award.

#### **15.4 Player of the Year Selection Process**

15.4.1 The Player of the Year will be the one Athlete receiving the highest number of votes in a specific Division for each sport.

15.4.2 If there is a tie the CAA Staff will distribute multiple Player of the Year awards

15.4.3 Tackle Football will have an Offensive and Defensive Player of the Year in each Division
