# **Executive Director Report:**

# **Traveling -Out of Town:**

Member schools - the CAA as you are aware is a state association and with being a state association we service schools outside the metro areas of Tucson and Phoenix. All member schools are guaranteed an even minimum number of Home games when the school registers for a seasonal activity. Forfeiting games to member schools outside of the metro areas is something our members need to address, it is not fair to those member schools and we must address this to deter. This is not a league wide problem but a problem, that it is recommended the members review at the annual constitution meeting.

## Athletes participating on teams but attend other schools:

Member schools - the CAA Constitution allows a member school to add athletes that do not attend your school through an appeal process that must be approved by the Executive Board. Students must attend another member school, associate member school, Online School or be a HomeSchool student to be eligible. Reporting these additions are mandatory, failure to report will result in a violation of CAA bylaws. Article 5.11 should be reviewed prior to appealing, just because a school does not offer a sport, does not make them eligible for your program.

# Postseason:

CAA continues to work on rental facility contracts with member schools and outside agencies. Baseball fields are our biggest obstacle at this time. If you have a baseball field and are interested in hosting CAA state tournament games please contact the CAA staff.

# **Covid/Rain/Heat - Cancellations:**

Member schools - any minimum required games that were unable to be completed due to Covid outbreak on your campus or Rain/Heat related must be appealed to the Executive Board for a ruling on how the game will be recorded. Please use the General Appeal form and submit it to the CAA Executive Director one week prior to the end of the regular season. Failure to appeal a required game may result in a forfeit awarded to the team canceled on.

<u>Hardship Appeal Ruling</u> - Skyline Prep HS - Request for Arbitration - Hearing officer has set a date/time for this appeal.

# **Swimming Bylaw Review:**

- \*\* Change the minimum number of meets required to "4" from 5.
