



TOURNAMENT HOSTING GUIDELINES

This document will assist schools when hosting any STATE TOURNAMENT GAMES

HOST RESPONSIBILITIES

- Facilities:
 - Provide a regulation facility and assuming any fees associated with them, such as facility rental fees or clean up fees, etc.
 - Provide a locker room or area for the visiting team.
 - Facility must be available at least 30 minutes prior to the game start time.
- Collecting Gate Admission Fees
- Paying for officials
- Report Game score immediately after the game.
- Pay Tournament Invoice within 30 days of receipt.

CAA RESPONSIBILITIES

- Set-up Tournament Bracket
- Assign officials and transfer fees to the officials.
- Update Tournament Bracket once game score is reported.
- Invoice school for any fees associated with the game.

CAA STATE TOURNAMENT ADMISSION FEES *(non-State Championship games)*

- Adults - \$5.00
- Students - \$2.00
- Children (5-under)- Free

STATE TOURNAMENT SCORE REPORTING

- Home AD is responsible for reporting the game score to Randy Baum immediately after the game.

OFFICIALS

- The League will assign officials.
- Host School will be invoiced for the fees.

BASKETBALL

- UA official Game Ball
- Scoreboard Operator
- Scorebook Individual

FOOTBALL

Besides the above guidelines, the HOST school for a Football State Tournament game must adhere to the following:

- UA official Game Ball
- Scoreboard Operator
- Scorebook Individual
- A certified medical professional as outlined in the rules.

SOCCER

Besides the above guidelines, the HOST school for a Soccer State Tournament game must adhere to the following:

- UA official Game Ball
- A certified medical professional

VOLLEYBALL

Besides the above guidelines, the HOST school for a Volleyball State Tournament game must adhere to the following:

- UA official Game Ball
- Scoreboard Operator
- Scorebook Individual
